This topic enables students to reflect on the separation of powers as fundamental to our constitutional purpose and to consider how our governmental system is working for ourselves and our posterity. This year’s Law Day coincides with Rhode Island Independence Day, the anniversary of the day our state became the first North American colony to renounce its allegiance to Great Britain.
