This program on probate practice is designed to introduce you to the most effective way to plan and administer an estate.

You will learn the basic procedures needed to plan the small-to-medium estate and the pertinent questions you need to ask to establish estate-planning objectives with your client. The speakers will review the forms you will use including forms relating to Credit Shelter Trusts, QTIP Trusts, and trusts for the benefit of minor children. They will also discuss peripheral documents such as living trusts and various types of powers of attorney.

The focus will then turn to the administration of a decedent's estate. Discussion will begin with the initial family interview following death, move through the various stages of the probate process, and review the estate and income tax issues of a decedent.

Ethical issues inherent in the planning and administration of estates will also be highlighted especially in representing spouses, fiduciaries or beneficiaries.

This seminar is designed for both new attorneys in their transition from law school to law practice and attorneys who are not involved in estate planning and administration on a regular basis. Be sure to register early for this very popular program.
