# **Immigration 101**

Thursday, April 26, 2018 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Rhode Island Law Center, Cranston

Subject to Supreme Court Rule IV 3 this course has been approved by the MCLE Commission for 3.0 RICLE credits

The topic of immigration has been in the local and national news, and the current administration has proposed several policy changes that would drastically affect immigration law. But what is the law as it stands now, and how will the proposed changes affect not only documented and undocumented immigrants already here, but also those looking to immigrate to the United States in the future?

This program will discuss the history of our immigration laws, and the different statuses immigrants can hold, such as temporary visas, lawful permanent residence, and U.S. citizenship. The speakers will also discuss the various bases on which individuals can obtain status, such as family relationship and employment, as well as other humanitarian avenues such as the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA), U Nonimmigrant Status (U Visa), and Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJ). There will also be a discussion of removal proceedings, including the conduct of the proceedings and forms of relief available.

During this session, attendees will receive an update on current events, such as the administration's executive orders, immigration enforcement, the status of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program, Temporary Protected Status (TPS), and refugee admissions.
