The recent U.S. Supreme Court decision in Prado Navarette v. California, is highly instructive to the issue of anonymous tips. The Prado Navarette decision, because it is so new, is virtually untested in any lower court, including Rhode Island. The Court held that the standard for evaluating reasonable suspicion based upon anonymous tips invokes a "totality of the circumstances" analysis. The speaker will discuss this new case as well as recent cases where extra-jurisdictional arrests are often a factor.
